With Norman Gaudet Head of School

Our Head of School, Norman Gaudet, is a passionate educator and visionary who has more than 20 years of leadership experience in independent schools around the globe.

Throughout his career, he has put children at the centre of education. At TFS, he helps our students confidently navigate our rapidly changing world by setting the school's strategic priorities, which include championing a STEAM curriculum, creating confidence in students' relationships with the natural world, and helping develop the self-confidence needed to thrive at our school and beyond.

M. Gaudet also oversees all aspects of the TFS Entrance Scholarship Program — a transformative opportunity for exceptional students who would otherwise not be able to access a TFS education due to financial barriers.

"Can't Wait!" will raise \$4.3M for the TFS Entrance Scholarship Program to welcome more exceptional students into our TFS classrooms.

As TFS launches "Can't Wait!", we sat down with M. Gaudet to talk about the TFS Entrance Scholarship's positive impact on recipients, our school and the community.

TFS Foundation: Why is the TFS Entrance Scholarship Program an important initiative at the school?

Norman Gaudet: Our scholarship program is important because the education we offer at TFS is unparalleled, so it's better for all of us when we get the chance to share what we do with even more amazing students.

I firmly believe that TFS is the model that other schools should try to replicate. We bring together academic rigour with unmatched bilingual fluency while prioritizing every child's well-being so they can thrive at our school and with the world beyond our walls.

You know, I was at a national education conference the other day, and the keynote speaker said that the most important thing in education today is preparing students to interface with three systems: the human world, the mechanical world and the natural world. Hearing that was so validating because that's our strategic plan, entirely. That's what we're doing at TFS. So, having as many talented kids as possible benefit from a TFS education and get prepared to take on the future is important for all of us.

TFS: What makes the TFS Entrance Scholarship different from others?

NG: We give more to recipients than some other schools might. While we do have partial bursaries available for families experiencing short-term financial challenges, the TFS Entrance Scholarship is a full scholarship.

We offer the full tuition because we know the opportunity can break a potential cycle of financial hardship for recipients. The research suggests — and we see it anecdotally — that education is a transformative pathway for recipients and their families. That's why the TFS Entrance Scholarship is always a fundraising priority for us; we want to make sure that as many kids as possible can unlock their full potential through a TFS education.

TFS: What qualities do you look for in scholarship applicants?

NG: Financial need aside, we look for strong academic standing, and applicants must also be excited and motivated to commit to the French language component of our education. But we also look at other qualities. Is this young person a kind person? Will they be a good citizen – a good friend to classmates? How do they present themselves? What are their interests? What do they want to do in the future? We really look at the whole child and all their skills and interests.


TFS: Multiple recipients have graduated from TFS to attend prestigious universities in Canada and abroad, some receiving scholarships into highly competitive programs at those schools. As an educator, what does their success mean to you?

NG: It means everything to see them succeed. I am so proud of all of our graduates, but knowing that, in some cases, this education would've otherwise been out of reach, I am deeply moved by what this school offers students. It also reinforces how gifted, motivated and hardworking these scholarship recipients are. When that's paired with the strength of our education, the sky's the limit.

The success of the school can be seen in every year's graduation photo. Every student adds something to the whole. Individually, the kids are confident, keen and well-equipped to pursue their dreams in university, college and beyond. Which means, as a group, they are the best graduating class we could possibly produce. And, coming from TFS, that means the world.

TES: How does the Entrance Scholarship Program improve the experience of TFS for all students?

NG: The program benefits our whole community because we select really great and proactive kids. So that means every other student and teacher has one more amazing, kind and dedicated kid in their class that they can now call their friend — their student.



When you meet Aidan Jordan, you can't help but notice his quiet confidence. He has an energy grounded in knowing what it means to bridge worlds, seize opportunities and dream big. His journey with TFS is deeply personal and universally inspiring.

"I didn't really know what I was getting into,"
Aidan admits about his decision to attend TFS.
He was encouraged by his mother and driven by
curiosity and applied without fully understanding
the scope of the opportunity. The school saw
potential in him that he hadn't recognized yet.
The school offered a scholarship that removed
barriers and opened doors to a future he hadn't
imagined.

At TFS, Aidan found himself navigating a new space that was filled with promise. "I've always felt like I'm straddling two worlds," he says. "But that's been my strength — I can relate, connect, and build bridges." His leadership extended beyond the classroom and sports fields, where he was a standout in soccer and basketball, to creating lasting impact through initiatives like the Black Excellence Society. "We needed a space to connect and really talk," he reflects. "It taught me empathy and gave me a sense of responsibility."

Empathy is at the heart of everything Aidan does. At Scott Mission Camp, where he transitioned from camper to counsellor, he broke language barriers with Spanish-speaking campers. "I know what it's like to feel out of place," he says. "The best advice I gave them was to be themselves and trust that the right people will come into their lives."

Now pursuing a dual degree in psychology and management at the University of British Columbia, Aidan carries those lessons with him. He's building the foundation for a future nonprofit to empower marginalized youth, an idea shaped by his experiences at TFS and the camp. "It's

not just about business for me — it's about creating something that helps people," he says. "I want to share what I've learned and make sure others have the opportunities I've had."

"At TFS, I learned how to say my dreams out loud — and more importantly, how to make them happen," Aidan says. Whether it's starting a music label, working in professional sports, or creating a nonprofit, he believes the foundation TFS gave him ensures he can build whatever future he envisions. "When you've been shown what's possible, it changes everything."

Aidan credits his parents and TFS for shaping his journey. "My parents sacrificed so much for me to be here," he says. "And at TFS, I was surrounded by people who didn't see limits — who encouraged me to aim higher and believe in myself." He recalls formative moments, like a teacher's candid advice: "Being nice will get you far, but you need to put in the work to stand out." While the words stung at first, Aidan recognizes their truth. "That pushed me to prove I wasn't just a nice kid — I was someone who could make real change."

As Aidan reflects on his time at TFS, he sees the ripple effect of his experiences. He learned to mentor younger students, work with teachers to address microaggressions, and inspire friends to dream bigger. "TFS equipped me to do anything I want in life," he says. "And if I can help someone else see their potential, like TFS did for me, then I know I'm doing the right thing."

Aidan remains unwavering in his purpose: to empower others, build connections, and create lasting change. His story is a testament to the power of opportunity, resilience, and the extraordinary things that happen when talent is supported.

The TFS Entrance Scholarship Program changes lives. It unlocks the potential of promising students. It also offers that opportunity without indebting or "othering" students and their families, which means recipients can dream without limits.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The TFS Entrance Scholarship is a transformative opportunity for exceptional, qualified students whose only barrier to attending TFS is financial.

The school established this scholarship program in 2016 through the generous giving of our community. Each year since, TFS awards one or more promising students entering Grade 7 or above a full scholarship, which covers tuition and ancillary fees like those associated with field trips and extracurriculars.

We cover these costs to make sure that scholarship students are never disadvantaged from their classmates and receive the full benefits of the TFS experience. TFS renews these scholarships annually so long as recipients remain in good standing.

The TFS Entrance Scholarship Program has supported 11 students, with the first recipients graduating over the last three years. These graduates have all continued their academic journey at prestigious universities in Canada and abroad, with some earning scholarships to competitive programs.

HOW IT WORKS

The TFS Scholarship Committee selects recipients through a rigorous vetting process. The committee reviews each applicant's academic merit, community involvement and financial need. It also hosts interviews with candidates to learn holistically about who they are beyond grades and essays and how they will get the most out of what our school offers.

School leadership does not disclose the identity of recipients to faculty, staff or the student body to ensure equal treatment.

The TFS Entrance Scholarship is an opportunity that can change a young person's life. It gives them a solid educational foundation. It introduces them to new ways of thinking, problem-solving and communicating. It also challenges any self-limiting notions they may have about their futures. This opportunity empowers scholars to unlock their potential, discover their passions and connect with trusted adults who can help them realize their dreams.

It's also an opportunity that touches the whole TFS community. Our scholars bring their skills and knowledge home and act as role models for their siblings. How are prospective students selected for the scholarship program?

The TFS Scholarship Committee selects recipients through a rigorous process. The committee reviews each applicant's academic merit, community involvement and financial need. It also hosts interviews with candidates to learn about who they are and how their interests will thrive at TFS.

Q:

What are the requirements students have to meet for the TFS Entrance Scholarship?

TFS offers an enriched bilingual and academic program, so applicants must demonstrate strong academics and be motivated to learn or improve their French language skills. Applicants must also demonstrate community involvement and a significant financial need to qualify for the opportunity.

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Once selected, how are scholarship students supported through their journey at TFS?

Scholarship students have equal access to our full suite of academic and wellness supports through the Learning Forum and by teachers, coaches and mentors. TFS leadership does not disclose a scholarship student's identity to faculty and staff to ensure there is no risk of prejudicial treatment. But, the Head of School meets with recipients throughout their time at TFS to ensure they are on track, well-supported and feeling good about their standing at our school.

Q:

How does the TFS Entrance Scholarship Program benefit other TFS students?

The scholarship program benefits our entire community because it means there is one more gifted, kind and proactive student at TFS to teach, learn from and befriend.
